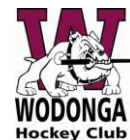

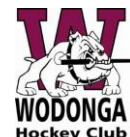

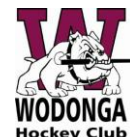


in the area, as well as for players trying our game for the very first time. The initiatives have included;

- Inducting a new Life Member – Della Poppins
- Further increased our sponsorship base over the 2014 season – adding Norske Skog, Hume Bank to the table
- Conducted our first “Registration Under the Stars” event at the Cube in Wodonga
- Conducted our first season launch cocktail event at the Blazing Stump
- Created our Clubs own “Fair go, Sport!” video
- Rolled out the Fair go, Sport! Program – extensive media publicity
- Increased Club profile by sourcing Club advertising on a billboard in Melrose Drive
- Revamped our Club newsletter - fully electronic via Mail Chimp
- Enhanced our web site for on line registration and payments
- Grew our Facebook followers to now an unbelievable 700 followers!
- Added further signage at the Wodonga Hockey Centre recognizing sponsorship and creating a future revenue stream
- Videoed and posted Division 1 Men’s and Women’s game – and posted on you tube
- Increased our financial support for our Clubs junior State representatives
- Successful conducted or annual Trivia/Silent Night auction, Dave Chandler Cup, Junior and Senior Presentations, Junior “Get Together”, Life Member Communication session, and Club Day

Further to the above listed items, I also wanted to specifically call out;

1. Life Member Inducted – At our Senior Presentation night, I had the honour to welcome Della Poppins as our Clubs newest Life Members. A terrific honour and well deserved for all of the hard work Della has, and continues to do, on behalf of the Wodonga Hockey Club.
2. Border Indoor Hockey – this competition was to attract new players to our game, add specialized skills to those participating, and to create a revenue stream for the Club with the aim of being re-invested in to growth programs. Pleasingly we have seen further growth in playing numbers rising from 80 last summer to 120 this competition. I ask all members to support this competition as it’s critical to our growth plans.



3. Wodonga Field Replacement – To ensure a suitable playing surface at the Wodonga Hockey Centre is a clear responsibility of HAW. Unfortunately plans were not in place for a timely upgrade. This has now been further complicated with the Wodonga City Councils Baranduda Fields Sporting Precinct. The executive continues to work “alongside” both AHW and the Council to ensure the best outcome for its members
4. Playing Numbers - The Committee is proud to say that key initiatives around increased media publicity, the Indoor competition, working closely with HV Road Show and local schools, and providing more competitive junior registration fees (only possible due to our increased sponsorship base line), has delivered for the second year in a row growth in our playing numbers, especially juniors – the life blood of our Club

Sadly, this season we saw the passing of our Clubs first Life Member, Noel Mason pass away. Noel was a much loved and honored member of our extended family who had a profound effect on this Clubs culture. Noels contribution to our Club is recognized via the Noel Mason honour board, and the Noel Mason Youth Encouragement Awards.

I was honored to be President of this wonderful Club for the 2015 season. Together with the Committee – one which is made up of some of the most passionate hockey people you could ever hope to work with, a lot has been achieved in a short period of time. We plan to further strengthen our Club in 2016 and work specifically on longer term strategic objectives.

The Wodonga Hockey Club is an amazing Club. A Club which is based around fun, family, and fair. As one big family, we may not always agree on all things or how things should be done, but at the end of the day, everyone has the best interests of the Club at heart, and you can't ask for more than that!
